Matters discussed

The GIA Financial Arrangements Joint Working Group (JWG) met for the sixth time on 27 August 2014 by teleconference to agree the approach and content for the 'Money matters' session at the GIA Biosecurity Forum 2014/II.

Before agreeing the session, the JWG was updated on how their work had been discussed with the Interim Fruit Fly Council (IFFC) and comments received on the Forum discussion paper. The IFFC met at the end of July and August and discussed what process might be used to arrive at an agreed beneficiary cost share. Four members of the financial arrangements JWG were present at the meetings.

The JWG agreed that the Forum session will reiterate the financial arrangements in the Deed that set the context for the work they undertook and the recommendations in the Forum discussion paper.

Following a presentation on the context in the Deed and the JWG's work, delegates will be asked for questions they may have on the guidance and how it was achieved. JWG members will answer the

questions, reflecting on the processes they used, the lessons they learned and the views they have formed along the way.
