To safeguard your industry, growers, producers and processors by ensuring they:

- want to be part of GIA ✓
- support funding GIA activities ✓
- see biosecurity as important ✓
- recognise the value GIA offers ✓



# Requirements in the Biosecurity Act 1993

Section 100ZA specifies that the signing industry organisation must:

- be a body corporate
- represent the sector (as defined)
- consult the sector
- have a strategy to fund GIA obligations (e.g. levy, savings, or loans).

The Minister must be satisfied that these requirements have been met.
